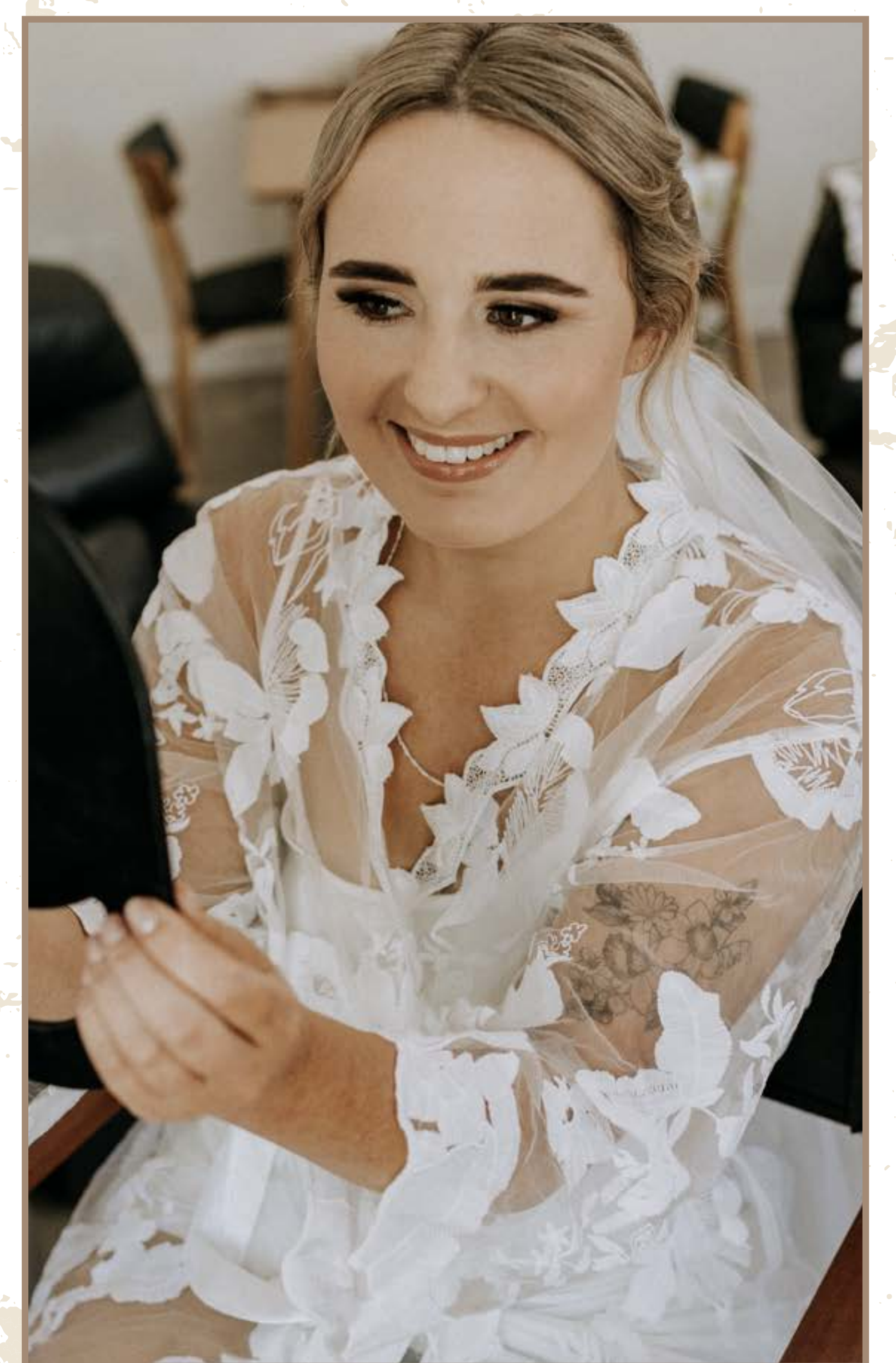

Trial Info & Prep



A few things you can bring with you to your makeup trial to help me with ideas:

- Inspiration photos of the look (or looks) you like from Pinterest, Instagram etc.
- Photos of your dress, bridesmaids dresses, florals or colour schemes of your wedding to give me an idea of the colours and what might look best with these.
- Information on your skin type and any issues you might have including any sensitivities.
- Any products you love or prefer to use on your day including lipstick.

Tips

- Try and line your makeup trial up with an event; hens party, bridal shower or even dress fitting, so you can get the best use out of the makeup, rather than just going home and taking it off straight away.
- Try and leave your makeup on for as long as possible after your trial, so that you can see how well it lasts and how it wears. This feedback is crucial for me, so I can make any changes for your day if required.
- Wear white or a light colour to your trial, so you can see how it looks against a colour that is similar to your wedding dress.
- Bring a friend or family member you trust to give you honest feedback and a second opinion!



Wedding Day

Information & Preparation

The goal is for you to ultimately relax and enjoy on the wedding day! I will bring everything I need for you on the day. However, a couple of things you can do to help...

- *Get plenty of rest the night before (or try your best to!)*
- *Drink lots of water for skin hydration.*
- *Have a clear face (no makeup), however do your usual skin prep (cleanse, tone, moisturise etc).*
- *If possible, clear a space near a window for natural light and out of the way of foot traffic for a makeup station. We may come in and move a few things around to suit. I will also bring a makeup chair with me.*
- *Get your bridal lipstick ready and any other products you want me to use.*
- *It's also helpful to have a rough idea of the order in which each person is going to get their makeup done, baring in mind I would prefer to do the bride's makeup roughly second to last if possible.*
- *I can also help put together a timeline for you if you prefer.*

Frequently Asked Questions:

Should I be doing any specific skin prep before my wedding?

This is completely over to you, however if you have any specific issues with your skin (e.g.: extreme dryness, texture, oiliness, acne, scarring etc) I would suggest getting onto it sooner rather than later. The worst thing you can do is start treating your skin with something new close to your wedding day. You will need to give your skin time to adjust to the treatment and the changes. I'm no skin specialist, but lots of water, eating good food and keeping your face out of the sun to avoid sun exposure and sun burn before your wedding day will help!

How long before my wedding should I do my makeup trial?

I would suggest doing your makeup trial closer to your wedding, ideally a month to two before. This usually works best as we can get a more accurate representation of how your skin is looking; tone, texture etc. As humans we all like to change our mind every now and then, so doing your trial closer to the wedding will also ensure you don't change your mind on your makeup look too many times before the day as well!

How long will you need on the day for makeup?

It depends how many people are in your bridal party of course, however I like to allow an hour per person. Often I don't spend a full hour on each person, however I definitely will on the bride. Mothers of the bride or groom often take a little less time (30-40 mins) as they often want minimal makeup. Flower-girls can take anywhere from 10-30 mins depending on age and how much makeup they need. We can discuss this on consultation.

What time should I have my makeup done by on the day?

This purely depends on your schedule and timeline for the day and also how far away from the wedding venue you are getting ready. I usually suggest all makeup being done about an hour prior to departure time. This gives you an hour to get dressed, do final touches, spray perfume, go pee and fluff about! Your photographer may also want to do some pre-photos of you and your bridal party, so you may want to factor this in as well. It always best to discuss this with your vendors.

Should I get my hair or makeup done first on the day?

I can work with either, however my personal preference is having your makeup done first and hair second. This is mainly so I don't touch any of the hairstylists work, as I will need your hair off your face for makeup.

Should I get semi permanent lash extensions for my wedding?

Absolutely your choice! Lash extensions can compliment makeup really well and really make your eyes pop. If they are in your budget, it is quite a nice idea as they do look really beautiful and romantic. They're also great if you think you might cry a lot! I think they're great for post-wedding too. If you are having a gathering the day after the wedding or if you plan on going on a holiday or honeymoon afterwards, they're a low maintenance way to look "put together" without makeup.
